

Gabriel has one feature film under his belt, as he portrayed the son of Ben Affleck and Zoe Saldana in the 2016 movie, *Live By Night*. He is anticipating his next big screen debut, in *Godzilla: King of Monsters*, May 2019.

Aside from acting and modeling, Gabriel would eventually like to obtain his first degree black belt in Tae Kwon Do. As if Gabriel's schedule was not busy enough, he has taken on the challenge of becoming a budding entrepreneur, taking action against the social injustices of bullying with clothing line, *Take Action Apparel & Gear* and International digital magazine, *Action Magazine*.

Quote Me...

Bullying: *"I was bullied for awhile when I was in school, not by one person but by several people. It made me feel very sad and upset because I could not figure out what I had done to make them dislike me so. I finally realized that it wasn't me, but them. Bullying is something that affects millions and millions of kids and adults. It is something that we need to take a stand against and help those who feel helpless."*

Martial Arts: *"I love martial arts. I started taking Tae Kwon Do lessons as a result of being bullied so that I could learn to defend myself. Martial Arts gives self-confidence, discipline, and self-control among other things to people. Because of my schedule, I don't get a chance practice like I use to but I hope to get back into it soon. It's a skill that goes beyond physical and becomes a part of who you are."*

Acting: *"Acting is not an easy profession. It is hard for adults, so you can imagine how difficult it can be for a kid. But, acting is something that I love to do. I get the opportunity to become someone else for a little while and tell a different story. To be a good actor, you have to be versatile, study and train hard, and know that you are not always going to hear 'yes'. But, when you do, it will make it just that much sweeter!"*

Modeling: *"Modeling doesn't come as easy to me as acting, but it is fun just the same. At first, I did not really like getting in front of the camera with my 'man makeup' on. It was a different experience than I was used to. At first, I felt uncomfortable. I was told to think of modeling as 'acting without words but body language'. Now, I can tell a completely different story behind the camera just as if it was a movie camera! And that, well, is definitely double the fun."*

Being a Kid: *"Being an actor/model is a job. I am officially a working kid! You have to do things as an "adult" but keep in mind that you are not. In my free time, I like to do things that many kids do. I play tons of video games, spend time with my friends and family, watch t.v., listen to music, practice piano, and play chess. I think one of my favorite things to do is hang out with my dog, Charlie. We spend a lot of time together since I am homeschooled, I sometimes think that he thinks that he is the older brother!"*


